Colleges and career schools use the FAFSA form to determine how much financial aid you're eligible to receive, which could include grants, scholarships, work-study funds, and loans.

The FAFSA application opened on December 1st. Prior to the College Goal event, create an account. Please write down your account information in a place you will remember as you will be using the information numerous times throughout the year. Go to Create Account | Federal Student Aid to start the process.

Finally, if you choose to complete the FAFSA application on your own, please make sure to complete an application for the "2025-2026" school year.
